SYMPOSIA, OR MEETING**

**DUPLICATE PUBLICATION:** Legitimate uses of the journal include publications of preliminary reports, such as an initial analysis of a limited case study or an assessment of early experimental findings of urgent interest. In both cases, the authors intend to expand their analysis in a complete study they will later submit for publication in *Transplantation Proceedings* or another journal. In contrast, duplicate publication is the verbatim inclusion of a subset of data derived from a much larger, already published or submitted analysis. Duplicate publication is wasteful of journal space and reviewers' efforts and may be a violation of copyright laws. *Transplantation Proceedings* has recently resolved to implement a series of sanctions should duplicate publication be discovered. Authors must agree that their manuscript has not been submitted or published in any other journal, including *Transplantation Proceedings*, and no parts of the manuscript are duplicated.

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**ABSTRACTS:** All manuscripts MUST contain an abstract of no more than 250 words which briefly summarizes the manuscript. Abstracts must be typewritten, double spaced, single columned on 8 1/2 x 11 inch paper with a minimum of 1-inch margins on all four edges using an 11-point font. Manuscripts submitted without an abstract will NOT be considered for publication.

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
